

MIKHEIL KHERGIANI CUP 2026

REGULATIONS

Participant Categories	Women and Men, aged 15 and above

1. Invited Countries and Organizations

- Sport climbing clubs from the cities and districts of Georgia
- Azerbaijan Mountaineering Federation (AMF)
- Sport Climbing Federation of Armenia (SCFA)
- Turkish Mountaineering Federation (TDF/TMF)

2. Competition Rules and Format

The competition will be held in the bouldering discipline, in accordance with the current World Climbing Competition Rules, unless otherwise specified in these Regulations.

Each team may consist of a maximum of four athletes and one coach. Participants must be aged 16 or older.

The competition will be conducted in two stages: Qualification and Final rounds.

- The Qualification round shall be open to all registered athletes. If more than 60 athletes are registered, the athletes may be divided equally into two starting groups: Group A and Group B.
- The Final round shall be open to the women and men ranked from 1st to 8th place in the Qualification round.

3. Provisional Schedule

4. Determination of Winners and Awards

Winners and prize-winners shall be determined according to the competition results.

Prize-winners shall be awarded medals and valuable prizes. First-place winners shall be awarded the Mikheil Khergiani Cup. All participants shall receive certificates.

5. Team Arrival, Accommodation and Expenses

Team travel expenses, including transportation, accommodation, meals and the participation fee, shall be covered by the sending organizations or by the individual participants themselves.

Participants and team officials are responsible for their own travel/medical insurance, health condition and personal belongings.

6. Registration

Preliminary applications shall be submitted through the online registration form no later than 02/07/2026:

Registration after the deadline may be accepted only at the discretion of the Organizer.

7. Appeal / Protest

An appeal may be submitted in writing no later than 5 minutes after the completion of the athlete's attempt, by the team coach or official representative.

The appeal fee is EUR 20. If the appeal is upheld, the fee shall be refunded after the completion of the tournament. If the appeal is rejected, the fee shall not be refunded.

8. Participation Fee and Payment Terms

The participation fee is equivalent to EUR 15, payable in Georgian Lari. The payment deadline is 02/07/2026.

9. Safety and Medical Support

An emergency medical team / first-aid service will be provided at the tournament. Nevertheless, participants are responsible for their own health condition and take part in the competition at their own risk.

Underage participants must provide appropriate consent to participate in the tournament from a parent, legal representative or sending organization.

10. Code of Conduct

All athletes, coaches, team representatives and participants are required to respect the judges, organizers, other athletes, volunteers and spectators.

Inappropriate conduct may result in a warning, removal from the competition area or disqualification.

11. Additional Venue Information

The tournament will be held at the Mikheil Khargiani Climbing Gym, where a shorter, 18-meter replica of the Olympic bouldering "TITAN" wall, presented at the Paris Olympic Games, is installed — the first and only such wall in the Caucasus region.

The boulders will be set using holds from World Climbing-related manufacturing companies.
